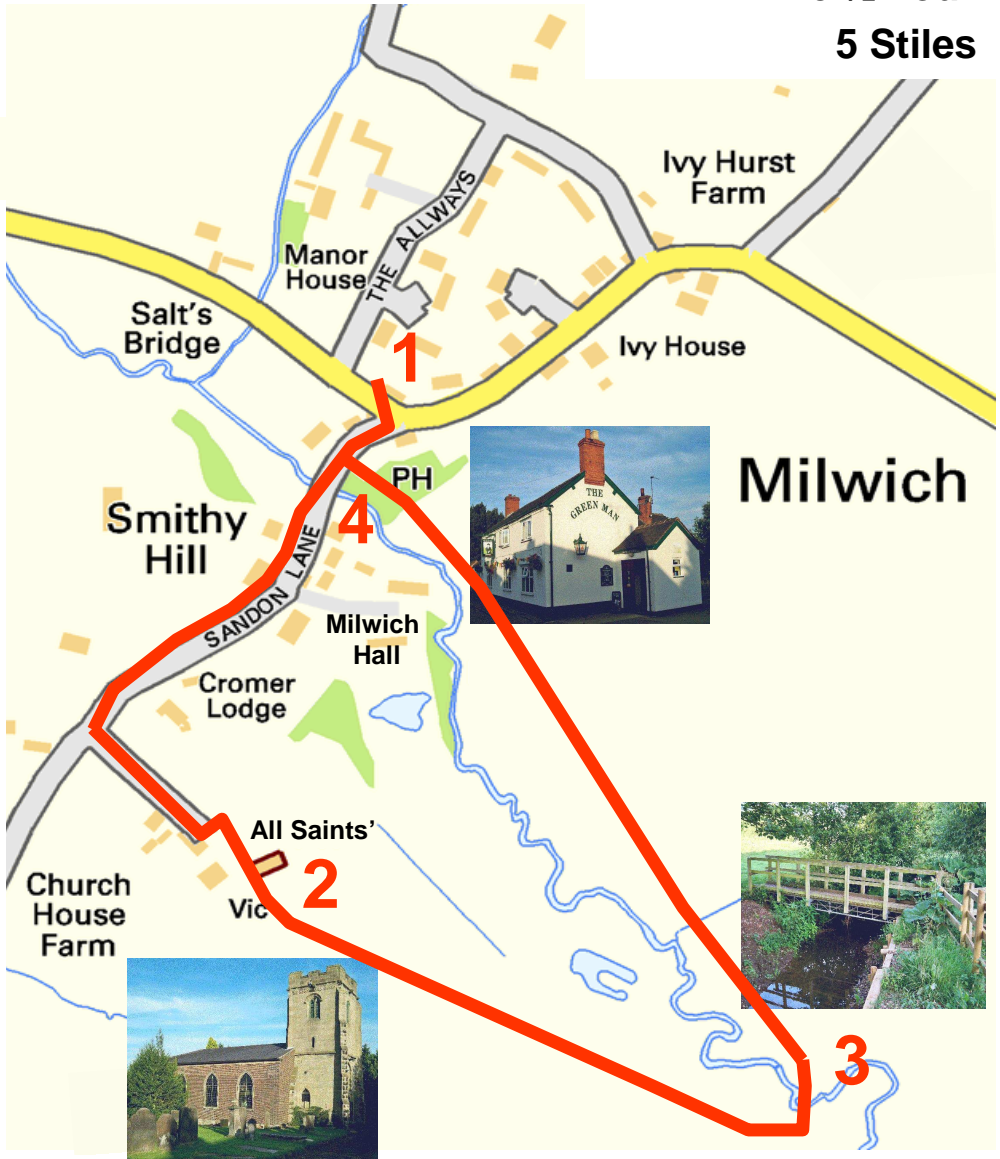


# All Saints' Milwich

Distance 1 mile  
Time ½ hour  
5 Stiles



## Directions

Cross the road from the Village Hall car park into Sandon Lane opposite. Walk past the Green Man and up the hill for 250m before turning left into a side road signed All Saints' Church.

After 100m go through the gate on the left-hand side into the churchyard. Turn right taking the path past All Saints' Church (2) to the gate at the back of the churchyard.

Passing through the gate follow the footpath straight ahead with the field hedge on your left hand side. At the bottom of the hill bear left to the footbridge across the brook (3).

Crossing over the bridge turn left towards Milwich keeping the brook on your left hand side. After 150m there is a double stile set in the field boundary.

Go over these stiles and straight on across the field, with the brook on your left, to another stile beside a farm gate. After this it's a short walk to a double stile leading into the garden behind the Green Man (4).

## All Saints' Church - Milwich

Over 800 years have passed since a Church was first recorded on this site when in circa 1140 Nicholas of Milwich granted it to Stone Priory.

On entering the church, overhead, is an incised gravestone dating from the 12th century and inside is a 13th century font.

In the belfry hangs the oldest dated bell in Staffordshire cast by John of Colsale in 1409. The other two bells were cast in 1670 and 1735.

The Church today serves both the Anglican and Methodist traditions.
